For the Journal, to end of 2010: **J 5/1** = HAFS Journal, Volume 5 Number 1, followed by date and page numbers, eg. J 5/1 May 1999 pp.19-22

From 2011 to 2024, References are indicated in this way: **J 11-1** = HAFS Journal, Vol. 11, Number 1, followed by month,

year and page numbers. This is consistent with the footers on each page of the journals for this time period.

For Newsletter: **N = Newsletter**, followed by number, month, year, and page numbers,
Eg. N 17 Feb 1999 pp. 8-9; N 41 Feb 2011 pp. 8-9

Hungerfords Down Under code is given in parentheses, from 2nd ed, 2013. Where possible, codes from HDU, 1st ed 2001, and from *Hungerfords of the Hunter*, have been updated to match HDU, 2nd ed 2013. Stray **Hungerfords** have been realigned in HDU, 2nd ed 2013, consequently some codes in this index may not match the codes used in the articles as published in early issues. Later codes have been updated following new research information. Codes for earlier Hungerfords have been assigned using Stanley Hungerford's codes, eg (SH 1429). Some of our American cousins have codes from The Hungerford Family Foundation Inc. (THFFI) website, eg (US26)

Research Notes:

Always check under the head of the family as well as the person being researched, in case an additional reference is to be found in a more general article.

Females are entered under both **maiden name**, and under **married name** (plus HDU code), even if this information is not in the article.

Cross references: **See** references and **See also** references have been inserted where several variants of the item indexed can be found. Please follow these, eg City to Surf (Sydney) **See** Sydney City to Surf

Photos: where these are included in an article, a notation has been added.
